Summer Writer in Residence

Students interested in writing about ecology, natural history, environmental ethics, or related topics may apply for the Friends of Lakeside Lab Writer in Residence Scholarship. The scholarship offers a \$1000 stipend and a three-week residency in the natural setting of the Lakeside campus to explore topics and work on writing.

Iowa Lakeside Laboratory and Regents Resource Center (ILLRRC) is a field station serving Iowa's state universities. Located on West Lake Okoboji in northwest Iowa, the Lab provides summer courses and research opportunities for college students and year-round public programs on a 147-acre campus.

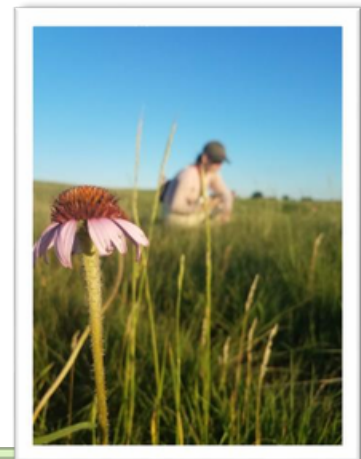
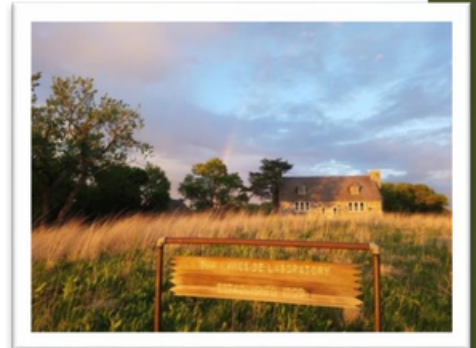
