

Earn to Learn Internship

The Earn to Learn Internship is available to college students to build career-ready skills in natural resource management. The internship provides:

1. One 4-semester hour course at Iowa Lakeside Laboratory.
2. \$10/hour pay for work related to internship (40 hours a week for 8-10 weeks; water quality monitoring, aquatic invasive species research, habitat restoration, grounds maintenance on Lakeside's campus, etc.).
3. Opportunity to gain experience with research either by assisting with on-going projects or developing an independent project.
4. Room and meals at Iowa Lakeside Laboratory for the duration of the internship.

The internship runs from mid-May to early August (exact dates are negotiable).

The internship is a partnership between the Friends of Lakeside Laboratory, Okoboji Protective Association (OPA) and the Clean Water Alliance – Water Quality Commission grant.

Eligibility

The Earn to Learn Internship is available to college students pursuing degrees in natural resources, environmental science or related fields.
