Primitive Hunting Tools

How did people of the past hunt for survival? What tools did they use? In this session we'll learn how to throw spears with an atlatl, learn basic archery, and even participate in some hatchet throwing!

Spring Birds of Iowa

What better time to learn about our avian neighbors than during spring migration! Participants will grab a pair of binoculars, head out and learn more about birding and the different species that live or fly through Dickinson County. Women of all birding skill levels are welcome to join!

Outdoor Cooking

Want to learn more about cooking on a campfire? In this session, participants will make recipes on an open fire as well as learn the basics of Dutch oven cooking. Recipes will be shared, and everyone will get a chance to prepare, cook and sample the food.

Canoes for Beginners

Join us on the water as we go over the basics of canoeing! We'll talk about safety, equipment, paddling techniques, and help participants refine their skills.
